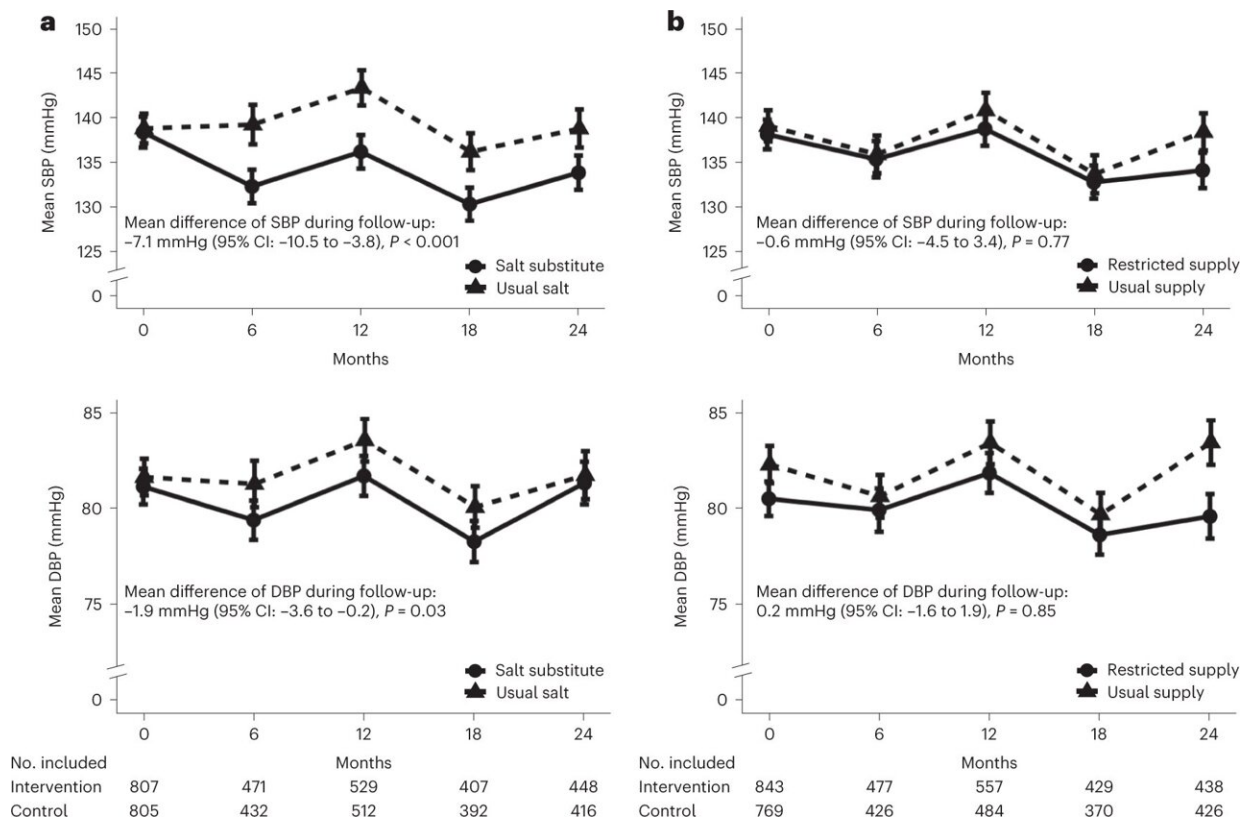


Exploring effectiveness of salt substitutes in elderly care facilities

Effects on BP. a,b, Effects of salt substitute versus usual salt (a) and progressively restricted versus continued usual supply of salt or salt substitute (b) on SBP (top) and DBP (bottom) are shown. Data show mean and 95% CI values at baseline and each follow-up visit. The mean differences and 95% CI in SBP and DBP between comparison groups are based on BP measurements at four follow-up visits and were estimated using a linear mixed model with repeated measurements, accounting for clustering effects and adjusting for baseline values. The P value was two-sided and was not adjusted for multiple comparison.
