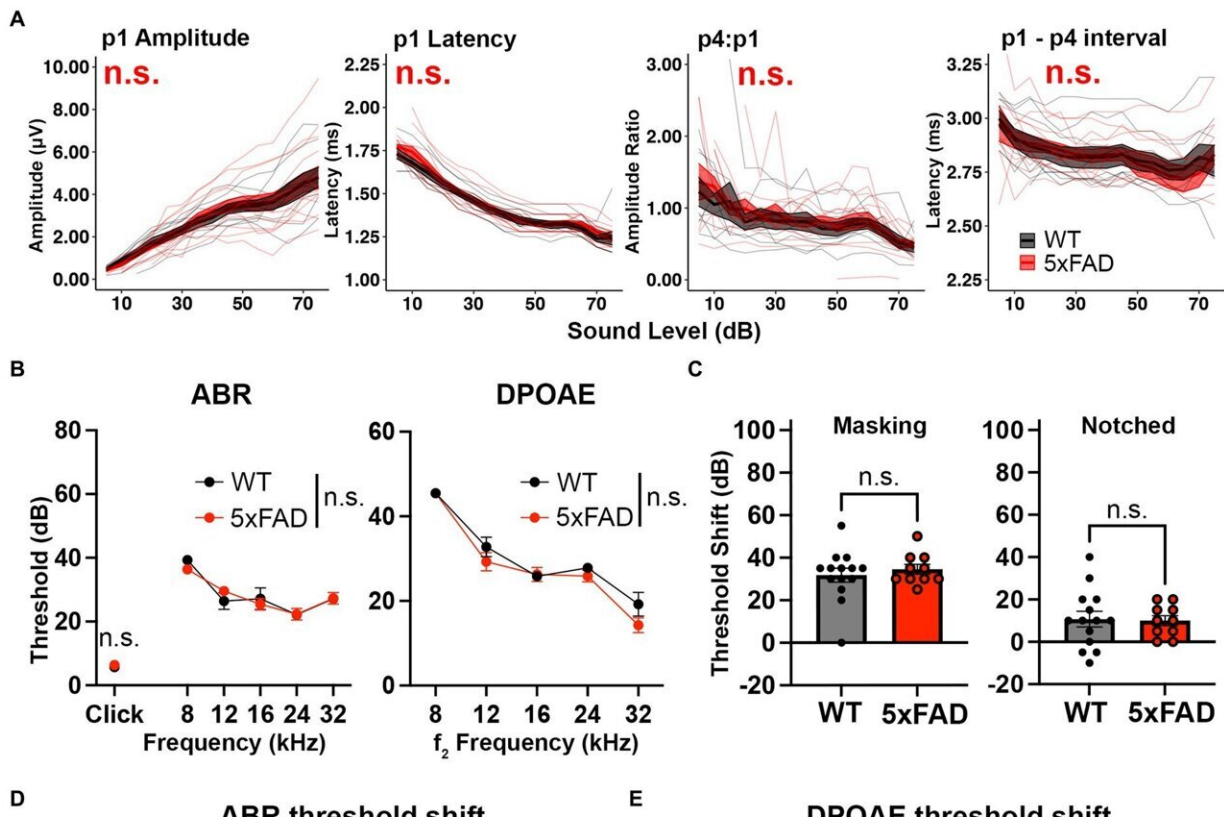


A chance observation finds potential hearing biomarker for Alzheimer's disease
