What you should and should not do regarding COVID-19 testing.

Before coming to a hospital, clinic or drive-thru <u>location</u> for COVID-19 testing, here's what you should and should not do:

You should do this

Call your local health care provider you show any sign of these COVID-19 symptoms:

- Fever
- Dry cough
- · Shortness of breath
- · Difficulty breathing

You should not do this

- Do not come to the <u>hospital</u>, clinic or drivethru location to be tested without calling first. This minimizes potential exposure to other patients.
